#### NOTE

- (1) The matters/cases, wherein the Apex Court had passed order for expeditious hearing/time bound hearing, be given priority. The matters of Senior Citizens / Marginalised section would also be given priority.
- (2) The Criminal Appeals pending for more than five years in which the accused is/are in Jail, be given priority.
- (3) The **Hon'ble Smt. Justice M. S. JAWALKAR** is appointed to hear and decide the matters under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- (4) The **Hon'ble Shri Justice ANIL L. PANSARE** is appointed to hear and decide the matters under the Companies Act, 1956, the Companies Act, 2013 and the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.
- (5) All the Hon'ble Judges, designated to try the Election Petitions under the Representation of the People Act, 1951, shall assign a date in the week as per their convenience, to deal with the Election Petitions.
- (6) Contempt Petition (Civil) will be taken up by the concerned Division Bench or Single Judge, as the case may be, before which the main matter is pending or before which the main matter would lie if it were pending.

- (7) Upon change of roster, Part Heard matters shall stand released and shall be placed before the Hon'ble Court as per the roster. However, if all the parties to the proceedings make a joint written request for retention of the matter before the Hon'ble Court which had partly heard the matter before the change of roster and if the Hon'ble Court endorses such request, the Registry would place the matter before Hon'ble the Chief Justice after verifying the record. Upon acceptance of such proposal by Hon'ble the Chief Justice, such Part Heard matter shall be assigned to the Hon'ble Court which had endorsed the joint written request of all the parties to the proceedings.

- 1) The urgent mentioning and placing of the matters pertaining to the Division Bench headed by the **Hon'ble Shri. Justice Nitin W. Sambre** is allowed before the Division Bench headed by the **Hon'ble Shri. Justice A. G. Gharote** and **vice versa**.
- 2) The urgent mentioning and placing of matters pertaining to the Division Bench headed by the **Hon'ble Shri. Justice N. B. Suryawanshi** is allowed before the Division Bench headed by **Hon'ble Shri. Justice A. G. Gharote**.
- 3) The urgent mentioning and placing of the matters pertaining to the Single Bench presided over by the **Hon'ble Smt. Justice M. S. Jawalkar** is allowed before the Single Bench presided over by **Hon'ble Shri. Justice Anil L. Pansare** and **vice versa**.
- 4) The urgent mentioning and placing of the matters pertaining to the Single Bench presided over by the **Hon'ble Shri. Justice G. A. Sanap** is allowed before the Single Bench presided over by **Hon'ble Justice Urmila Joshi – Phalke** and **vice versa**.

**NOTE**

- (A) This would also include the matters in which any Division Bench passes an order "not to place any particular matter before a bench of which one of the Judges is a member" or a Hon'ble Single Judge passes an order "not before me" or "remove from board", etc.

- (B) The aforesaid directions shall be in force until the present assignment continues.
